Create your next back or front quilt, using the Mandala Technique of Dyeing fabric.

Please click on the address on the picture to see the example of "How to Directions."

Materials needed:

- * 108" backing fabric (or smaller) in white. It can have a design woven into it.
- * Purchase bottles of liquid RIT dyes in the colors that you desire for your fabric.
- * Large spray bottle that we will fill with water.
- * Large plastic bag that you will use to carry your wet project home in.
- * Cotton or nylon cording for tying the fabric. This can be found at a craft store or hardware store.

Wash and dry before dyeing the fabric. This will wash off any residue. Dry on high heat to shrink fabric.

In class we will discuss the technique for dyeing and tying. You will take your project home and let the dye set in for 24Hrs.

Rinse out thoroughly and dry. (use vinegar in the rinse cycle to set in colors).

It will be hard to wait, but you can do it.
