Class date: July 12. 2025 Instructor: Jacqueline Doctor Johnson DESCRIPTION: Students we learn how to use; Gimp, Adobe Acrobat, save as a PDF to assist in creating there images into a POSTER., for quilts and appliqués.

- * You will need to save your image unto a Flash drive or usb. Save as a jpeg or PDF.
- * You can go to: quilter<u>cache.com</u> to find free ideas and images to save, bring those to class.

STEPS:

- *Open your computer, then insert your flash go to my documents and open flash click on your image and drag it unto the desk top.
- * Click on GIMP to open, you can get GIMP 2.10 free on your home computer.
- * Drag your image into the screen.
- * Go to the crop tool click to remove any back ground (I will demonstrate in class).
- * Go to menu: scroll down click on scale image, then inches scale to your desired size, click on scale to lock in your size., with a 300.00 resolution. (DEMO)
- * You can press the minus key to bring into the screen view .
- * Go the File: scroll down to Export as; click on select file Type: scroll down to pdf. Click and give it a name, save it on the desk top and you can also save unto your flash drive.
- * Open Adobe acrobat reader: click on open file, click on your file, click open.
- * Go to menu click print, when open click on POSTER, title 100% overlap 0.005 click Print (DEMO).
